COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY HOUSING INFORMATION FOR AMERICAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM STUDENTS

Summer, 2015

American Language Program students can choose to stay in a Columbia University dormitory near the campus. You can live in your assigned unit year if you continue to be enrolled for full-time classes at the American Language Program. *All ALP rooms are air conditioned.*

Some dormitories have "suites" with 6 to 12 students living in each suite. You will share a bedroom (called a "double") with one other person and share bathroom and kitchen facilities with others in your suite. You will have a single bed, dresser, wardrobe, chair and desk. You must provide your own linen, towels and pillows. Rooms have ethernet ports for internet access and telephones. There are laundry facilities in the basement. All double rooms are single sex. Each suite has two bathrooms - one for males, one for females.

There is <u>no smoking</u> allowed in the dormitory.

Only full-time students are eligible to live in Columbia housing.

ALL STUDENTS MUST SIGN THEIR CONTRACTS THE FOLLOWING DAY AT 401 WEST 119TH STREET BY NO LATER THAN 4PM. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Everyone who stays in University accommodation must follow the Rules and Regulations of Housing. If you do not, your housing contract will be canceled and you will have to leave the dormitories. All residents must be clean, quiet, and considerate of other students. You will be sharing with full-time Columbia University graduate students studying for degrees. As specified in the "Terms and Conditions of Residence" of your housing contract: **Noise which disturbs other Residents is prohibited.** Overnight guests are not allowed in a double suite room accommodation. If you want to have visitors, host a study group or have a party, you must talk to your roommate and suitemates about your plans in advance. You also need permission from your Resident Advisor. You must use headphones when watching television, or listening to music or the radio if others can hear the sound outside your room.

Students who apply for housing *after* May 15, 2015 for the Summer session will be automatically placed on the waitlist. Please note that the U.S. \$300.00 money order is non-refundable.
